	You must be enrolled half time (6 credits hours in Fall or Winter, 3 credit hours in Summer) to qualify for	
	financial aid for your off-campus study. You can combine credit hours from the host institution with credit	
	hours from Detroit Mercy Law (e.g. online courses).	
	You must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements to participate.	

Financial aid will not be processed until all requirements listed above are satisfied.

Re	quirements during participation:
	All financial aid funds disbursed to you must be used for your educational purposes only. This includes
	tuition and fees at the host institution, books and supplies related to class(es) for which you are enrolled,
	your personal housing and board costs, direct transportation costs associated with getting to and from the
	host institution or study site, and personal costs associated with the time enrolled in the host institution.
	You must stay enrolled half time or more throughout the time of your study. If you withdraw from or drop
	any classes you must notify both your host institution and the Financial Aid at Detroit Mercy Law.
	Withdrawal from classes can affect Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) and make you ineligible for
	future financial aid.
	You must adhere to all policies of the host institution and the study site while participating in the off campus
	study opportunity.
