Registration Times:

Students with 51 earned* credits and above as of January 2016, April 4 @ 8:30 a.m. - August 28 @ midnight

Students with 22-50 earned* credits as of January 2016, April 11 @ 8:30 a.m. -August 28 @ midnight

Students with 5-21 earned* credits as of January 2016, April 18 @ 8:30 a.m. -August 28 @ midnight

*Earned credit hours do not include credit hours students are currently registered for as this term's credits are not earned to date.

First Year, Rising 2L Day Students & Upperclass Dual JD Students:

- All first year courses are required courses.
- First Year and Upperclass Dual JD students will be registered into their required courses by the Law School Registrar's Staff.
- The rising 2L Day division students will be registered into Constitutional Law I and Professional Responsibility (unless they are registered for Professional Responsibility in Summer 2016) by the Law School Registrar Staff.
- Rising 2L students who earned below a 2.0 in a required course must register and repeat that required course the next time it's offered and earn at least a 2.0 in that required course for continued matriculation. Students who possess an overall GPA of less than 2.60 at the end of their first year, second semester will be required to register for Law 2010, Business Organizations; Law 2100, Criminal Procedure; Law 2130, Estates & Trusts, and Law 2490, Sales and pass with at least a grade of 1.0 as a condition for graduation.
